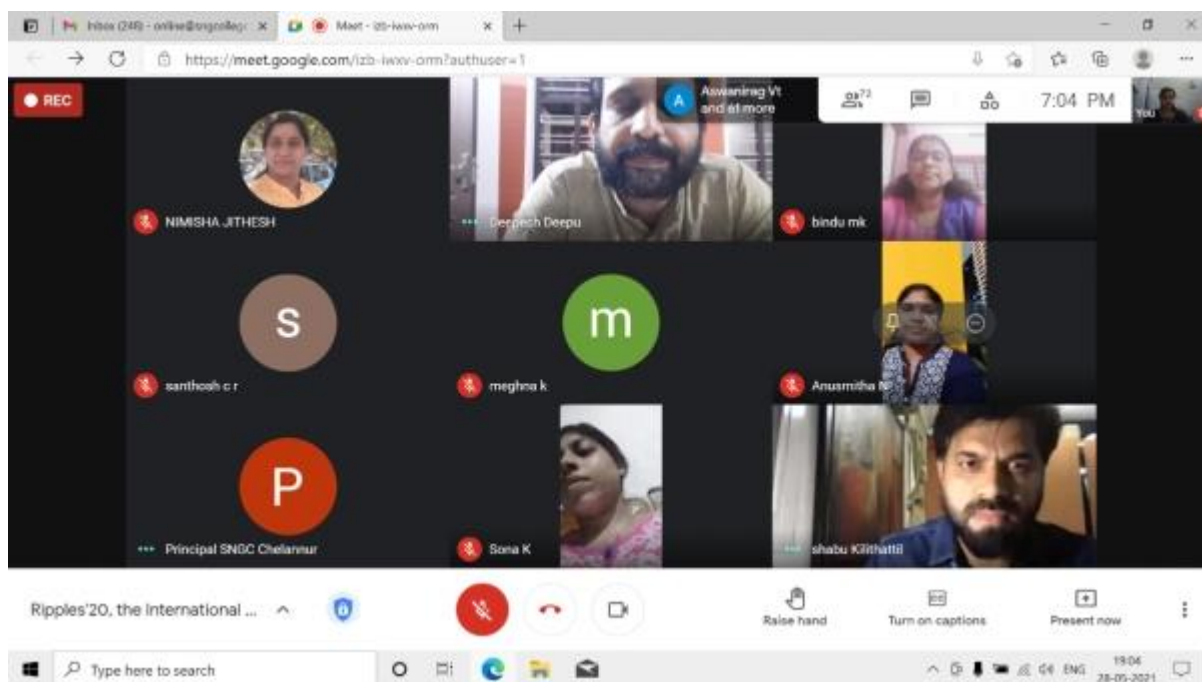


2020-2021 Academic Year
