

Introduction

Sree Narayana Guru College, Chelannur, named after our guiding spirit the great seer Sree Narayana Guru and founded by Sri. R. Sankar, the former Chief Minister of Kerala started functioning in 1968. This vast campus of 67 acres is situated at the foot of the towering Kalari Hills, about 14 kilometres from the city of Kozhikode. This college stands tall with seven UG and three PG programmes and is one of the prestigious institutions of higher education managed by the Sree Narayana Trusts, Kollam. The college is affiliated to the University of Calicut and has been accredited with B⁺⁺ Grade (CGPA – 2.89) in the second cycle of by NAAC Re- accreditation.

With great pride and pleasure, we present this annual report of Sree Narayana Guru College, Chelannur, which is celebrating its Golden Jubilee this year, as an authentic record of our activities and achievements during the academic year 2018-2019. In projecting our accomplishments and drawbacks, it is a self-assessment of our strengths and weaknesses. We also hope that this report would inspire us for an introspection to overcome our hurdles, resolve our drawbacks and work harder to be more productive and promising in all areas of activity, so that our institution can scale greater heights of glory in the years to come.

The Academic Committee constituted by the college council, comprising all Heads of Departments, one elected members of the staff, designed the academic plans for the academic year by charting a detailed Academic Calendar, in the beginning of the academic year itself. The College Council constituted various clubs, committees etc. each under the supervision of a convener with 3-4 members of the faculty. A Brief Report of the Activities of Clubs and Committees

Sree Narayana Guru College with the commitment to Quality education and training, has attempted to propel the wholistic growth of our students. We shape our students by honing their skills and instilling a sense of responsibility towards nation building by cherishing humane values. In our efforts towards the above-mentioned goal, we have conducted different activities to bridge the gap between the institution and the industry. We assess the students' strengths and weaknesses in academics and aptitude and address their needs through Remedial & Tutorial classes, Assignments, project work, Seminars, guest lectures, workshops etc. Use of Information & Communication Technology (ICT) and other visual aids support, enhance, and optimise the delivery of information in education. Integrating technology to the curriculum has a significant and positive impact on students' achievements. A brief report of the activities of different clubs and committees are given below.

Orientation Programme

Sree Narayana Guru College organized an Orientation Session for the first-year UG students. It was a half day session where the students were made aware of the curriculum and various facilities in our college campus. The programme started with a prayer and the inauguration was done with lighting of the lamp by respected Principal – Dr. Devipriya V. This was followed by a detailed explanation of disciplinary rules of the college by IQAC Coordinator Dr. J.Mayadevi. Power point presentation was used to explain the scheme of examinations which included both Continuous Assessment and Semester end examination. The session was coordinated by the Ms. Sangeetha G Nair, the Convenor and Ms. Neethu. P member of the Orientation Committee. Volunteers of senior batches also helped to carry out this activity. Faculty members introduced their students to areas regarding course

instructions, syllabus and the related curricular activities and solved their queries regarding the same.

Apart from the academic pattern, the students were also made aware of the various extracurricular activities organized by college. There are various Clubs in this institution. All institutional committee co-ordinators have given orientation to the students regarding their respective clubs.

Parents Teacher Association (PTA)

The Parents Teacher Association (PTA) of the academic year 2018-19 started from the month of June 2018 under the leadership of Dr. Devipriya V, Principal (President), Smt. Akhila M K (Secretary), Sri Sivadasan Master (Vice President) and other executive members representing parents and teachers. The College PTA plays a significant role in finding the ways of improving the life and performance of students in areas, academic, social, cultural and ethical. It mainly takes into account the welfare and education of the student's community in order to bring up well educated, cooperative and perfectly behaved young citizens. In order to help the college, realize its purpose, the PTA plays an important role which includes expenses relating to running and activities of the college. It acts as the life blood and nerve centre of the institution. As a PTA, with its limited fund, it is trying to fulfil its objectives to a great extent and to help the college to manage its day-to-day activities. Being the main functional support of the developmental activities of the college, PTA bears the monthly electricity and telephone charges of the institution. PTA meets the monthly salary expenses of 4 non-teaching staffs who are appointed by PTA for the smooth functioning of the college. PTA also undertakes the responsibility to give salary the cleaning staff. The majority of the

maintenance work related to water supply, electricity etc are undertaken by the PTA. The other major activities carried out by PTA from June 2018 to November 2018 were the purchase of Camera for official photography, Installation of CCTV camera in and around the campus, Assistance for meeting the expenses relating to college cleanliness and maintenance, quarry waste accumulation, departmental expenses, preparation of boards in and around campus, stationery expenses, sports hostel expenses, maintenance and cleanliness of girls' and boys' toilets, and also meeting medical expenses of students. In the month of November, a general body of PTA was conducted and PTA was reconstituted under the leadership of Dr. Devipriya, Principal (President), Sri. Sivadasan Master (Vice President), Smt. Joobi V P (Secretary) and including executive members representing parents and teachers. In addition to the aforementioned day to day activities the newly reconstituted PTA has made a great effort in installation of the water purifier and sufficient CCTV cameras in the campus. PTA also provided assistance for college union, cultural, departmental and various club activities of the students. In this academic year PTA could install Projector in the seminar hall and provided camera and external hard disc to record the various activities of the institution.

In this academic year, "Drinking Water Project" was the important contribution of PTA, which provided drinking water facility to the college and hostels with the help of digging a borewell in the campus, costing rupees 125000/-. As part of Golden Jubilee Celebrations PTA provided financial assistance to conducting Departmental Exhibitions, "Extravaganca" to showcase the talents of the students and teachers and thereby disseminating the valuable information and knowledge to the students of neighbourhood institutions. And also, as part of Golden Jubilee celebrations PTA organised "Guruvandanam" for honouring the former teaching and non-teaching staff who served the institution for the last 50 years of the college. This year as part of academic excellence PTA launched a Multi-Disciplinary Seminar Series, Ripples with the whole hearted cooperation of the 18 individual departments. In addition to this PTA assisted conducting departmental workshops for enriching the students with practical skills. For the purpose of eradicating the problem of unemployment a *Job Fest* was also conducted with the support of PTA. PTA purchased 2 Alamara for library and PTA and also Tables and Chairs in the seminar hall. The other major contributions of PTA 2018- 19 extends from meeting the expenses relating to installation of Route map, Provisional affiliation of M.com batch, Fine arts day celebrations, purchase of fans in the departments and class rooms, purchase of plumbing materials, library barcoding, printing attendance registers, college calendar and tutorial cards, maintenance of computers and CPU, purchase

of animal specimen, purchase of Tele Vision to Sports hostel, office stationery expenses, Fixing of name board and photos of former Principals, UGC visit to Banglore and Trissur. In addition to this PTA also advanced for the proper functioning of NSS camp and WWS classes. Moreover, PTA helps the 11 Guest lecturers by providing refundable advance for meeting the daily expenses in every month.








• Extension Lecture Programme on the Adwaitha Philosophy of SreeSankara


• Workshop on Research Methodology


On Day 10, there was only one seminar –the final in the series of 18 seminars of Ripples-2018 organised by the Department of Chemistry. Here the invited lecture was on
