

Introduction

Sree Narayana Guru College, Chelannur, named after our guiding spirit the great seer Sree Narayana Guru and founded by Sri. R. Sankar, the former Chief Minister of Kerala started functioning in 1968. This vast campus of 67 acres is situated at the foot of the towering Kalari Hills, about 14 kilometres from the city of Kozhikode. This college stands tall with seven UG and three PG programmes and is one of the prestigious institutions of higher education managed by the Sree Narayana Trusts, Kollam. The college is affiliated to the University of Calicut and has been accredited with B⁺⁺ Grade (CGPA – 2.89) in the second cycle of by NAAC Re- accreditation.

With great pride and pleasure, we present this annual report of Sree Narayana College, Chelannur as an authentic record of our activities and achievements during the academic year 2020-2021. Postgraduate Department of English


• Webinar(22-09-2020)

The Postgraduate Department of English conducted a webinar on the topic "Anthropocene F(r)iction: Art, Politics and Climate Change" as part of the *Imago2020 Multidisciplinary Webinar series*, at 8pm on 22nd September 2020 on digital platform.

The welcome address was delivered by the Head of the Postgraduate department of English Dr. J Maya Devi. Welcoming the resource person Lt. Aravindan SS, Assistant Professor, Mahatma Gandhi College, Thiruvananthapuram and the other delegates, she introduced the topic by briefly talking about the significance of the term Anthropocene in the current context of situation. The webinar was inaugurated by Dr. Sindhu Krishnadas, Head of the department of Economics. Ms. Athma Jayaprakash, the IQAC coordinator offered felicitations. It was followed by the talk and presentation by Lt. Aravindan S S. He tried to relate the environmental changes and other issues, and enumerated the causes of the issues, and also illustrated how these are reflected in arts and literature. "The term Anthropocene which was suggested as a geochronological period to the scientific community by Paul Crutzen and Eugene Stoermer, quickly came to encompass both the fantasies of human exceptionalism and the ensuing cultural crisis. The present talk began by introducing these complex set of relations that animate the realm of the Anthropocene. Using this as a point of departure, an attempt was made to situate art into this new emerging politics of climate".

Around 110 delegates from all over the state of Kerala and outside participated in the webinar. The vote of thanks was proposed by Ms. Vandana Viswanath, Assistant Professor, Department of English.

The webinar came to a close at around 9:30pm.



• Online Orientation Programme for MA English Students(26-02-2021)




• World Book Day Program(23 April 2021)




• Ripples'20



• One Day Webinar on Drop Shipping



• Ripples 20 Webinar on Nanotechnology Based Energy Harvesting and Storing Devices




• International Wildlife Day:


The programme was both informative and entertaining. The sincere participation of both the students and the teachers made this programme a huge success. The interaction session




Innovation Club

Literary Club






