

#### Introduction


## Post Graduate Department of Biology




# **National Science Day**




# **Ripples Multidisciplinary Webinar Series**






## Webinar on the Spring Season of Chemistry



#### Online Orientation on Banking And Financial Sector










#### **ICTEDIS-2021 under the Auspices of IQAC**








## Kona Kona Siksha - Certificate Education Programme







#### IMAGO - Report 2021-22




## **Ozone Day Celebration**



The resource person for the webinar was Sri. Jiju K. R, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry, SN College, Alathur. 




# Power Quiz- 2021


# Sree Narayana Guru College Volleyball Team Secured First Position In Calicut University A Zone Volleyball Championship


## Conducted Selection trails for the college Men cricket team

# **Youth District Championship**



### **Tutorial meeting 21.06.2021 to 24.06.2021**











## **Report of ICTEDIS Webinar**



## Seminar on the International Day for Eradication of Poverty





## **Online Quiz Competition on Nobel Laureates in Literature:**






#### **Author's Day Celebration**

- 3. Ayana LS II B.Sc Maths



#### **NATURE CLUB ACTIVITIES**







# **CULTURAL PROGRAMMES**


(THEME: DRUG ABUSE)


## ONLINE CLASSES AND PRECAUTIONS FOR EYE HEALTH IN THE EVE OF COVID 19 PANDEMIC






#### **TEACHER'S DAY-05-09-2021**








# **SAY NO TO DOWRY-** 10-09-2021











### NATIONAL BLOOD DONATION DAY -01-10-2021




# INTERNATIONAL GIRL CHILD DAY-(11-10-2021)






## **Quiz Competition**

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



Food and accommodation were served by the volunteers of Nss of Mar Baselios College of engineering and technology, Thiruvananthapuram.
















### **AIDS DAY-**01-12-2021




### **Armed Force Flag Day**






### **HUMAN RIGHT DAY- 10-12-2021**












### NSS 7 DAY CAMP- 24/12/2021 TO 30/12/2021

Programme Officers Shri Jithesh CP, Dr. Bindu MK, other teachers, NSS secretaries and volunteers were also participated.























### WORLD CANCER DAY-04-02-2022






GPS Map


# **WOMEN STUDY CENTRE**






#### INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY CELEBRATION ON MARCH 8TH








Kargil Vijay Diwas - July 26




#### Green Clean Kerala project.

#### FIT INDIA FREEDOM RUN 2.0



#### **VIJAY DIVAS**


