

Introduction

✓ <u>10-12 August 2022</u>

The I and II-year students of the PG Department of Biology underwent training on "Water Quality Monitoring Techniques" from the Centre for Water Resources Development and Management, Kozhikode from 10-12 August 2022. The training included physical, chemical, and bacteriological analysis of water and how to interpret pollution and report making. The training started with water sampling techniques and it was conducted in a field study mode. the students themselves collected water from the nearby water bodies and collected water samples for the analysis. On the first day of training had a class on bacteriological water quality issues followed by a lab analysis of the same. The students detected the major water pollutants like total coliforms, fecal coliforms, and E.coli from the water samples. The second day began with a small session on the different chemical parameters and the same was analyzed in the laboratory. Around 16 chemical parameters like chloride, alkalinity, iron, phosphate, nitrate, BOD, etc were learned through hands-on mode. The final day was about learning the physical quality of water and the same was learned through lab practices. The students also got an opportunity to operate various instruments like a colorimeter, incubator, spectrophotometer, etc. The training concluded with feedback sessions and the distribution of certificates. This training has encouraged the students to test the water and understand the rate of pollution through all the above-mentioned tests.




✓ 21 December 2022




✓ <u>06 February 2023</u>



✓ 01 March 2023


The PG Department of Biology, Sree Narayana Guru College, Chelannur along with IQAC offered free drinking water testing program for the private well owners who reside around the campus. This extension activity aims to promote drinking water testing and to educate the good owners on the importance of maintaining the quality of water. This academic year 10 water samples were collected from different open wells around the campus. Students of the Biology department collected the samples and analyzed the physical and chemical bacteriological quality of water using 17 different parameters. Most of the open wells had pH issues and reported the presence of total coliforms. Solutions were suggested to the Well owners as to how to chlorinate their water to maintain its quality. Reports were created under the supervision of Dr. Megha P U, HoD, PG Department of Biology, and the report was also issued to these Well owners within a week of analysis.

The programme was conducted on September 29, 2022, in the Seminar Hall. The function, which started at 10am, began with a prayer rendered by Hanna PP (II MA Eng). Seethal P (II MA Eng) welcomed the gathering. The inaugural address was delivered by the Principal, Dr.Kumar SP. In his address, he emphasized the growing relevance of writers like Gurnah, in the contemporary world. RIPPLES SEMINAR CONDUCTED BY THE PG DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH ON 27.02.2023




REPORT OF THE CLASS PTA MEETING OF VI SEMESTER B.A.ENGLISH(20-23)








ICTEDIS – 2022




STUDY TOUR TO GOA AND DANDELI FOR INSTITUTION VISIT AND VEGETATION STUDY


March 8 International Women's Day



'KILIKALKKU KUDINEER'






WORKSHOP ON MANAGING WASTE THE BEST WAY




COMPLAINT BOX






SREE NARAYANA STUDY CENTRE

World Environment Day (05/06/2022) World Environment Day was first celebrated in the year 1974. This day has become a platform to raise awareness among people regarding the problems





WORLD POPULATION DAY (11/07/2022)





















Women's Equality Day (26/08/2022)

National Sports Day (29/08/2022)






WORLD FIRST AID DAY [10/09/2022]


Krishnadas T. The programmes were well co-ordinated by SUO Bhavana P and SUO Ashaika Sajeevan along with other cadets.


NATURE CLUB ACTIVITY 2022-23

Nature has conducted one more session for cleaning activity by the nature club members .They have cleaned their class rooms and laboratory within the scheduled time allotted for their cleaning.




NATURE CLUB CONDUCTED ONE DAY VISIT TO VEGETATION STUDY FOR THE NATURE CLUB MEMBERS



The guest of honour was the two retired teachers out of five. Due to some personal reasons they couldn't join the meet. Total of 40 alumni were present.


The objectives of the meet were:

Alumni meet 18/3/2023




Grievance Box



CLASSES IN ENGLISH FOR EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION – FOR SCHOOL STUDENTS – 2022-23


The Postgraduate Department of English, Sree Narayana Guru College, Chelannur, conducted a one month course in Communication Skills in English, for the Seventh standard students of Ichannur Aided UP School, Kannankara, Chelannur. The course was conducted in the months of February - March 2023. The classes were held on all working days for a period of 40 minutes, depending upon the schedule intimated by the school authorities. A class of 25 students was arranged based, primarily, on the interest of the students and also their needs. A pretest was conducted to identify the students who really required help in using the English language. A team of four students from II MA English was assigned the charge of engaging the classes. One teacher from the department accompanied the student-teachers to the school, everyday. It was observed that the presence of student-teachers had a favourable effect on eliciting responses from the school children. During the sessions held this year, we concentrated on the basic reading and writing skills of the students. Every day, a new passage was given to the students for loud reading practice. A few words from the same passage was given for dictation also. The corrections were explained and they were asked to write down the correct words. The students were also motivated to read books as much as possible. These sessions were mainly meant to generate, in the students, a keen interest in the English language.




INNOVATION CLUB (YIP)

KAS Mentor, which would enable them to be a part of the free online competitive examination training classes scheduled to begin from November.










Orientation Programme on BFSI Career Strategies









NSS STUDENTS BUILT A LIBRARY IN ADOPTED VILLAGE








NSS students with anti-drug activities


PG DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS


Tutorial Meeting Of Commerce Department



Workshop on Bottle art




soaps were illustrated and the making process was carried on by the kudumbashree members along with ED Club members
