


TRIBUTE TO THE NOBEL LAUREATE IN LITERATURE, 2023, JON FOSSE





RIPPLES ANNUAL MULTIDISCIPLINARY SEMINAR SERIES-WEBINAR REPORT


discussion session on the topic. Many students and teachers actively participated in the session, cleared their doubts and shared their comments.


DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY

VISIT TO MALABAR BOTANICAL GARDEN AND INSTITUTE FOR PLANT SCIENCES (MBGIPS), KOZHIKODE

Malabar Botanical Garden and Institute for Plant Sciences (MBGIPS) is located in Olavanna Grama Panchayat of Kozhikode district in Kerala. Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate change, Government of India has approved MBGIPS as a leading botanical garden in the conservation of aquatic plants. In 2015, the garden became a Research Institute under the Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Environment (KSCSTE). It is home to more than 400 Indian aquatic plants and is the largest collection in the country in this category. It received Leadership award from the National Academy of Biological Science in 2014.


The teachers and students of Botany Department, Sree Narayana Guru College, Chelannur, visited MBGIPS, Kozhikode on 7th December, 2023. The garden is a biodiversity hub for diverse plant groups.

The students visited almost all conservatories in the garden and witnessed the amazing biodiversity of plant groups. They visited the bryophyte and pteridophyte section, balsam and bigonia house, star forest, spices garden, medicinal garden, systematic garden, orchid house, cactus house, butterfly park, valley of gingers and bananas, aquagene, herbarium etc. The garden was a wonderful academic experience for the students.

PARTICIPATION OF THE STUDENTS IN VARIOUS CLUBS






RIPPLES 2023-'24





Ripples










DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY








CODE OF CONDUCT COMMITTEE REPORT



WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY (JUNE 5)









INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY (JUNE 21)






"TECHNO EMOTIVE PEDAGOGY".




Both students and staff members participated in the charitable initiative.




FILM CLUB 2023-24






WORLD AIDS DAY (01-12-2023)

READING WEEK CELEBRATION




Utilization of Harvest:



The participants were excited to see the results of their hard work and the abundance of the harvest.


They learned valuable lessons about the importance of proper harvesting techniques and the care

experiences.






SHARE AND CARE CLUB


Orientation Programme


presided over the program.








ENVIRONMENT DAY CELEBRATION- 05/0






Election awareness programme- (19/2/2024)




NATURE CLUB


ENVIRONMENT CLUB








ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT CLUB REPORT
