


International Yoga Day (21/06/2022)




International Day Against Drug Abuse And Illicit Trafficking (26/04/2022)






WORLD POPULATION DAY(11/07/2022)

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
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
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




Women's-Equality-Day (26/08/2022)






WORLD FIRST AID DAY [10/09/2022]
