
# SREE NARAYANA GURU COLLEGE, CHELANNUR NCC ARMY WING ANNUAL REPORT 2024-25

### **INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY- JUNE 21**



NCC Army Wing of Sree Narayana Guru College observed Yoga day on 21st June along with Naval wing and NSS unit of SNGC.






June 26 at Mananchira Square under 9(K) Girls Battalion.










Independence Day is celebrated annually on 15 August as a public holiday in India commemorating the nation's independence from the United Kingdom on 15 August 1947,












The cadets were able to provide the lunch for the inmates for the day. Cadets reached there and served them Biriyani on the special day.






Later the official programme began with a warm welcome to the residents of the Ashagram .The


The Republic Day celebration was a resounding success. It provided a platform for students to express their patriotism, showcase their talents, and learn about the importance of

Army wing NCC unit of Sree Narayana Guru college celebrated merit day at college. Through this ceremony cadets were honoured for their achievements and contributions over the last year.








