CAREER GUIDANCE AND PLACEMENT CELL SREE NARAYANA GURU COLLEGE CHELANNUR REPORT 2020- 2021


The Career Guidance and Placement Cell helped students to prepare for suitable careers and created a lot of job opportunities for the students in 2020-2021. The cell conducted workshops and training program on career orientation, higher study options, self-employment, and entrepreneurship management to make the students aware of educational and career choices. Experienced resource persons gave career counseling to students. Soft skill training programs to facilitate the students in recognizing and nurturing their talents, various soft skill training programs were arranged on communication skills and personality development, stress management. Seminars were conducted for the students on interview skills and industrial awareness to gain success in their careers. To bring about voluntary commitment and involvement among students performance motivation classes were conducted. The cell has been especially keen in conducting thought provoking and motivating programs. Based on the instrumental guidance offered by the IQAC, the cell geared up its interaction with the faculty, student community and resource persons. The academic year witnessed the organization and conduct of nearly eleven fully fledged programs. Besides the conduct of such programs, the cell took initiatives in starting a coaching class on a regular basis from 3.15 pm to 4.30 pm. The coaching class proved to be an additional boon to our college students. The cell realized its worth in maintaining a continuous relationship with the former students and their presence in such coaching programs is sufficient proof. Following is an enlistment and descriptive report on each of the programs conducted by the cell.

The objectives of the cell are

- To organize seminars and guidance workshops for informing students about the emerging professional trends and events, job profiles, leadership roles, entrepreneurship, market needs and to impart training in soft skills.
- 2. To enable and equip the students with the tactics and techniques to appear for competitive examinations and interviews.

1. Orientation Class on "Foundation to Civil Service Exam"

An orientation program titled "Foundation to Civil Service Exam" was conducted in collaboration with **SKY Career Line** Near Stadium Junction Calicut, on **21/07/2020** through Google meet. 105 students from various departments participated in the class. Resource person **Dr. Asok Menon, Director of Sky Career Line,** explained the class and discussed about various aspects of the preparation for the exam including Time management, exam pattern, planning a structured study, Practice testing, revision, update current affairs etc.



2. Soft Skill Development Programs

Soft skill Development was conducted on 17/08/2020. The program was aimed at offering training for life skills and soft skills, so as to augment communication skills and personality development. Resource person **Sri. Shakkeer A.M** from the company, **Goan Institute International Consociation of Education Pvt.Ltd.**, explained the selection process, monthly salary category, desired profile and nature of job for the students. 50 students participated.



3. An Orientation class on ACCA

An Orientation class on "Door to Global Opportunity was conducted. Through ACC, eligible graduates will be able to start their career in the private service. In view of this we arranged an orientation class for those students who are ACC aspirants as well as those who are appearing. The class was handled by Sri.Hijas Hashi, Faculty of Logic School of Management on 13/09/2020 through Google meet. Students were very much enthusiastic in attending the class where the resource person discussed about the various aspects of effectively preparing for

the exam. He emphasized the importance of familiarizing with the complete syllabus and told the students that it requires utmost dedication and sincerity as well as seriousness on their part to get through this prestigious exam which covers a really vast syllabus. He later discussed about the exam pattern and the important sources to collect information to successfully face the exam. Almost 105 students participated in this online class.




4. Orientation Programme for tutors on Career Prospects



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
6. Personality Development programmes
