Our Institution

Sree Narayana Guru College, Chelannur, named after our patron saint, the great seer **Sree Narayana Guru**, was founded by the eminent visionary and educationalist **Shri. R Sankar**, the former Chief Minister of Kerala, in 1964. The foundation stone of the college building was laid in February 1968 and classes started in June 1968 with a Pre-degree batch. The Degree classes started in the year 1975 and the PG courses were begun in 1995. At present the College stands tall with 7 UG and 3 PG programs and is one of the prestigious institutions of higher learning run by Sree Narayana Trusts, Kollam. The college is affiliated to the University of Calicut and has gained the 2(f) and 12 B recognition of the UGC. The institution has been accredited with B++ Grade (CGPA -2.89) in the second cycle of NAAC Re-accreditation in November 2016. The college has crossed its golden jubilee in the last year and has accomplished fifty one years of service in the higher education, catering largely to the needs of students belonging to socially and economically backward families, often hailing from rural areas.
